Unit Standard:

- Develop learning strategies and techniques [12457]

Course Objective:

To assist learners with managing their own learning. They are able to demonstrate an understanding of the types of learning resources, learning and assessment methods and techniques available, and identify, evaluate and select those appropriate to their needs.

- Use random events to explore and apply probability concepts in simple life and work related situations.

Outcomes: At the end of the course the learners will be able to :

- Identify and discuss types of available learning resources and learning and assessment methods.
- Evaluate and select appropriate learning resources and learning and assessment methods and technique.
- Evaluate the effectiveness of the selected learning resources and learning and assessment methods.
- Reflect on learning experiences and developed learning strategies and techniques.
- Evaluate and report on progress with the learning process.

Contents:

- Identify various learning styles, and use those appropriate to the individual.
- Identify advantages and disadvantages of various learning strategies.
- Identify and utilize various learning resources appropriate to the individual.
- Identify and discuss types of learning and assessment methods
- Evaluate and select appropriate learning resources and learning assessment methods and techniques
- Evaluate the effectiveness of the selected learning resources and learning assessment methods
- Reflect on learning experiences and developed learning strategies and techniques

Assessment and Certification:

- Assignments to be submitted within two weeks following training. One follow up day is required to give feedback on assessed assignments. A PFSA Certificate of Competence is issued to successful candidates
- Relevant credits may be awarded to successful learners upon MERSETA due approval process.

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
